Plenty of Choice

There are six engine options, rear-wheel or four-wheel drive, three different cab sizes, and three different lengths of load beds. There are six models with new, or improved, exterior, and interior optional extras. One thing that's not changed is the fully boxed steel frame with a military-grade, high-strength aluminum body.

Prices

All the options available ensure that there is a pickup for every budget. You can go for luxury or bag yourself a great basic truck. The XL basic model starts from \$28,940. The Limited version starts from \$70,825 for a luxury-style truck.

Hybrid Version

It was rumored that the hybrid was going to be a plug-in style. However, it is more akin to a Prius with both a gas engine and an electric engine. This ensures good fuel economy and good range. The hybrid comes with 430 horsepower, 570lb-feet of torque, and a 700-mile driving range.

Work Benches

The shifter looks completely normal, but, when parked up, you can press a button and it folds down. The top of the center console then folds out over where the shift stick had been. This provides you with a flat surface for a laptop or small tool work. The tailgate, when open, also has a work surface made of nylon and glass. Built into it are even rulers (in inches and centimeters), pencil holders, and screw holders too.

Power Outlets

In the bed of the truck, there are covered power outlets. The hybrid version can actually operate a 240v washing machine from there. In the back of the cab, there are four more power outlets of different shapes. There is a cigarette lighter-style outlet, USB, USB C, and a household-style outlet. There is an optional extra called Pro Power Onboard. The vehicle can generate 2000w of power, which Ford claim can power a jackhammer!

The tailgate

On previous models, people used the tailgate for woodworking, which caused damage to the bodywork. With this in mind, cubby holes have been fitted, designed for C-clamps, which is ideal for DIY and on-site work. A pop-out step, and even a handrail, appears from the tailgate at the touch of a button. This improves access to the bed and folds away neatly, and easily, to close the tailgate. Another cool addition is the light on the back, perfect for hitching in the dark or finding dropped tools.
